Dear Dean Professor Dr. Jansbek:

I am writing to report to you on the work done at Stanford University by Stanislav Kuznetsov, who is I understand in the course of being habilitated as a Doctorate.

In the first place, we were very pleased with his excellent command of English so that he was able to participate as a regular member of the staff in the Laboratory of Hypnosis Research which is a part of our Department of Psychology in the School of Humanities and Sciences of Stanford University. This also permitted him to work directly with students who participated in his experiments, and he performed the hypnosis in English and was able to conduct appropriate interviews with those who participated in his experiments.

The scientific work he did here was of a high order, combining some of the work he had done previously on prolonged hypnosis with appropriate physiological measurements. The results that he obtained will be publishable in standard scientific journals.

During the year that he was here he made a most favorable impression upon all of us by his energy, enthusiasm, steadfastness, and scientific ability. He read widely and became widely acquainted with American psychologists across the country, so that in many respects he knew more that was going on currently than many of us on the scene.

I believe that he is headed for a very substantial career in investigatory work and in teaching. We has my full endorsement for any promotion that is open to him.
